Protective gloves

Protective gloves should be changed regularly, especially after intensive contact with the product. For every workplace a suitable type of protective gloves must be selected. The glove material has to be impermeable and resistant to the product/ the substance/ the preparation.

- **Material of gloves**  
Butyl rubber, BR  
As there are many different conditions in every day work these indications can only serve as an aid to orientation for the selection of suitable gloves for the handling of chemical products. By no means they can replace qualifying examinations by the end-user. These recommendations only apply to the product mentioned in the safety data sheet. When mixing with other substances or under conditions deviant from norm EN 374 a manufacturer of CE-approved gloves should be referred to. The selection of the suitable gloves does not only depend on the material, but also on further marks of quality and varies from manufacturer to manufacturer. As the product is a preparation of several substances, the resistance of the glove material can not be calculated in advance and has therefore to be checked prior to the application.
- **Penetration time of glove material**  
The exact break through time has to be found out by the manufacturer of the protective gloves and has to be observed. The determined penetration times according to EN 16523-1:2015 are not performed under practical conditions. Therefore a maximum wearing time, which corresponds to 50% of the penetration time, is recommended.
